Junior Great Books

Usually meets twice each month. All meetings take place at Creek Valley, with one adult volunteer leader for every 5-7 children. Most groups meet before school, during recess or after school in the Media Center.

Jr. Great Books is an optional reading discussion group for 3rd and 4th grade students. All students are invited to participate, regardless of reading ability. Parent volunteers lead the discussion, and groups usually meet twice a month at Creek Valley. Registration takes place in the fall. There is a \$20 fee, which covers the cost of a Jr. Great Book for each child. (The book is different depending on grade level) Some copies are donated at year-end, and are available upon request. Parent volunteers commit to meet with the same small group of kids throughout the year (usually 5-7 per group), and prepare a lesson based on the story. A guidebook is provided for each discussion leader.

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
